

## The Acute Rehab Difference

When you are preparing for discharge from the hospital, your healthcare team may recommend continued care before you go home.

There are important differences which you should know about because at a quick glance it appears that both types of rehab offer therapy, physician and nursing care with programs designed for a variety of illnesses and post surgical recovery.

Close medical supervision by physician with specialized training	Physician interaction once or twice a week; specialized training not required
24-hour rehabilitation nursing	Not required
Multidisciplinary team of physicians, nurses, case managers, therapists	Not required
Three hours of rehab daily	Not required
Physical, occupational and/or speech therapy	Not required

#### PHYSICIAN INVOLVEMENT

**Acute Rehab:** Physician care is provided 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and a rehabilitation physician (physiatrist) or nurse practitioner visits every day.

**Skilled Nursing Facility:** Medicare patients in some sub acute rehab skilled nursing facilities may not see a physician more than once a week or in some instances even longer.
